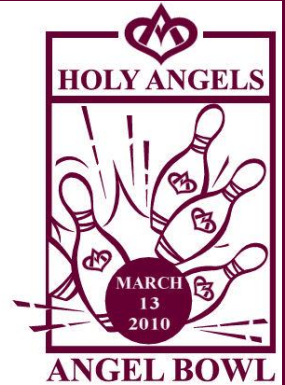


Angel Bowl Facts- Are You Up to the Challenge?

How Can You Participate In Angel Bowl?

Team Captain Registration Instructions:

- Fully complete the registration form
- Return it to your coordinator along with \$7 for each registered bowler. (Be sure to keep the pink copy.)
 - Unless notified otherwise, you will receive your 1st choice bowling time. Lane assignments will be published in "Angel Bowl Updates" closer to the event date

Team Captain

Responsibilities:

- Set a minimum team fundraising goal of \$500.
- Recruit 4 teammates and return fully completed registration form to your coordinator
- Provide your teammates with event information and pledge packets
- Motivate and encourage teammates to reach their individual fundraising goals and/or work with your teammates to meet the team fundraising goal together
- Distribute Angel Bowl T-shirts upon receipt from your coordinator
- Communicate lane assignment to your teammates
- Check-in at the registration table at George Pappas' Liberty Lanes 30 minutes before your bowling time at Angel Bowl on Saturday, March 13, 2010
- Turn-in pledge sheets and money collected by your team
- Enjoy an exciting game of cosmic bowling at Angel Bowl on Saturday, March 13, 2010
- Collect any outstanding pledge sheets and money from your teammates and submit to your company coordinator for return to the Holy Angels Foundation by Friday, March 19, 2010
- Make plans to be part of the 19th Annual Angel Bowl in 2011

Team Bowler Responsibilities:

- Set a minimum individual fundraising goal of \$100
- Request event information and pledge sheets from your team captain as needed
- Aspire to reach your individual fundraising goal and/or work with your teammates to meet the team fundraising goal together.
- With very little internet savvy, you can visit <http://www.firstgiving.com/holyangels> and set up *your own online fundraising page* to facilitate increased donations by emailing your family, friends and co-workers and directing them to your webpage where they can donate online!
- Arrive at George Pappas' Liberty Lanes 30 minutes before your bowling time for Angel Bowl on Saturday, March 13, 2010
- Turn-in any pledge sheets and money collected to your team captain
- Get bowling shoes and go directly to your assigned lane as communicated to you by your team captain and/or Angel Bowl event staff
- Enjoy an exciting game of cosmic bowling at Angel Bowl on Saturday, March 13, 2010
- Give any outstanding pledge sheets and money to your team captain for submission to your company coordinator to return to Holy Angels by Friday, March 19, 2010
- Make plans to be part of the 18th Annual Angel Bowl in 2011
